WALKING IN SEARCH OF WATER ALSO **THREATENS THE PERSONAL SAFETY** OF MANY WOMEN AND CHILDREN, ESPECIALLY IN COUNTRIES **EXPERIENCING CONFLICT.** THIS LIMITS THEIR TIME FOR OTHER ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING **EDUCATION, GROWING CROPS, PREPARING FOOD AND INCOME GENERATING WORK.**
